



How We Work

The Aid For Humanity signs a contract agreement with the institution wishing to implement charitable projects in Bangladesh, and the agreement includes the following:


- Assess the project site and prepare project proposal with budget.
- Submit proposal to donor, get approval from donor.
- Approve the project from Govt. and receive the fund from donor.
- Start the project implementation and assign a project manager to make the reporting easy and effective.
- Provide photos, videos or other items to donor of each step.
- After completion of the project, submit photo, video (along with report if needed) to donor.
- Appoint CA for financial audit, pay vat & tax, receive certificate of completion from local authority and submit completion report with beneficiary list to the Govt.



After the both parties agree on all the terms, the institution begins implementing its projects directly under the supervision of its specialized employees and trained workers and provides the financing party or donors with the required periodic reports supported by photographs-videos and a delegation from the donor institution may make a field visit to the project.

Our Ablution Projects are also called Medium and Big Well Project. These spaces are vital for ensuring that individuals, especially in rural or crowded areas, can perform their religious obligations with dignity and cleanliness.

The project supports mosques, religious schools, and public gathering spaces where clean water and sanitation infrastructure are often lacking. By focusing on quality construction, proper drainage, and gender-sensitive design, it helps reduce health risks and upholds the spiritual and physical well-being of worshippers, including orphans, widows, and those in marginalized areas.

With each well, we reduce the risk of waterborne diseases, alleviate the physical burden of fetching water—especially for women and children—and support daily needs such as drinking, cooking, and ablution.


The Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ) said:



Rohingya Response

The Rohingya Response Project by Aid For Humanity is a comprehensive relief initiative dedicated to supporting the displaced Rohingya community in Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh. Since the violent military crackdown in Myanmar in 2017, millions of Rohingya Muslims, predominantly women and children, have fled to Bangladesh, seeking refuge in overcrowded camps. In response, Aid For Humanity has been actively involved in providing vital humanitarian support to ease their suffering and help them rebuild their lives. Our ongoing efforts include LPG supplies to ensure that families have access to safe cooking fuel, and food and other essential aid to meet their basic nutritional needs. We also focus on water and sanitation, providing clean water and maintaining proper sanitation facilities to prevent the spread of diseases in the camps. Additionally, Aid For Humanity conducts medical camps, offering crucial healthcare services to the refugee population, many of whom suffer from physical and psychological trauma. Cloth distribution ensures that refugees, particularly women and children, receive clothing to help them cope with the harsh living conditions.

To further support the community, we are engaged in shelter renovation efforts, improving the living conditions of the displaced families.





